Conduct physical exams, diagnose and treat common illnesses and injuries, and provide immunizations. Also monitor high blood pressure, diabetes, and other chronic problems. Order and interpret X-rays and other lab tests. Provide patients consultation on healthy lifestyles. Manage client charts and documentation.

**Qualifications:**

Master of Science in Nursing required.

Must have clearance with New York State as well as the federal Drug Enforcement Agency to prescribe medications.

Five years experience post-master's degree. Experience working with children preferred.
